- I believe and therefore I speak (to my mountains). 2 Corinthians 4:13

- No weapon formed against me shall prosper, And every tongue which rises against me in judgment I shall condemn. Isaiah 54:17

- 'It is not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' says the Lord of hosts. Who are you, O great mountain? Before ______ you shall become a plain!
 And he shall bring forth ... shouts of "Grace, Grace to it!" Zechariah 4:6-7
- In the Valley of Vision, there will be a breaking down of the walls and of crying to the mountains. **Isaiah 22:5**
- Hear, O you mountains, the Lord's Complaint. Micah 6:2
- And I will prophesy to the mountains, and say, 'O mountains, hear the word of the Lord! Ezekiel 36:1
- Behold, I am against you, O destroying mountain, who destroys all the earth, and I will stretch out my hand against you. Jeremiah 51:25
- Behold, the Lord will make me into a new threshing sledge with sharp teeth; I will thresh the mountains and beat them small, and make the hills like chaff.
 Isaiah 41:15-16
- Every valley shall be exalted and every mountain and hill brought low; the crooked places shall be made straight and the rough places smooth. Isaiah 40:4
