

Passion for Purity

Declare the Word of God over your Life:

I am a child of God, born-again, filled with the Holy Spirit, redeemed by the blood of the Lamb. I do not live by bread alone but by every Rhema Word that comes out of the mouth of God. **John 1:12; 3:3,7; Ephesians 5:18; Revelation 5:9; 1 Peter 1:18,19; Deuteronomy 8:3; Matthew 4:4; Luke 4:4**

I will not be conformed to this world, but I will be transformed by the renewing of my mind so that I can prove the good and acceptable and perfect will of God. **Romans 12:2**

I will overcome the devil by the blood of the Lamb, by the word of my testimony and by not loving my own little even unto death. **Revelation 12:11**

"Man shall not live by bread alone but by every Rhema Word that proceeds from the mouth of God." Matthew 4:4 "Let it be to me according to your Rhema Word." **Luke 1:38**

"Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Rhema Word of God." **Romans 10:17**

"And take up the sword of the Spirit which is the Rhema Word of God." **Ephesians 6:17**

"Let these words be your weapons as you fight." **1 Timothy 1:18 (Today's English Version)**

Some Scriptures are paraphrased into prayers

The Lord has provided a way by which every believer can walk in holiness and purity and freedom from the lusts of the world around us as we walk in obedience to His Word.

Christ makes me pure and holy, I Declare:

- My body is not for sexual immorality but it is for the Lord. I will flee sexual immorality because every sin that I commit is outside my body but if I commit sexual immorality I am sinning against my own body. And my body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. I was bought with a price therefore I will glorify God in my body and in my spirit which are God's. **1 Corinthians 6:18-20**
- For this is the will of God, even my sanctification that I should abstain from sexual immorality, that I should know how to possess my own vessel in

sanctification and honor, not in the passion of lust like the Gentiles who don't know God- for God did not call me to uncleanness, but to holiness. **1**

Thessalonians 4:3-7

- I will walk in the Spirit and not fulfill the lusts of the flesh. And because I am Christ's, I have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. **Galatians 5:16,24**
- I will have clean hands and a pure heart and will not lift up my soul unto vanity. **Psalms 24:4**
- I will set no evil worthless thing before my eyes. **Psalms 101:3**
- I have made a covenant with my eyes, why then should I look upon a woman. This would be a fire that would consume to destruction and would root out all my increase. **Job 31:1,12**
- By means of an immoral woman I would be reduced to a crust of bread, and an adulteress will prey upon my precious life. Therefore I will not lust after her beauty in my heart, nor will I let her captivate me with her eyelashes. **Proverbs 6:25-33**
- Whoever commits adultery with a woman lacks understanding. If I would do it I would destroy my own soul. A wound and dishonor is what I would get, and my reproach would not be wiped away. The spirit behind immoral women has cast down many wounded, and all who were slain by her were strong men. Her house is the way to hell, descending to the chambers of death. **Proverbs 7:26-27**
- I will therefore not give my strength to women, nor my ways to that which destroys kings. **Proverbs 31:3**
- I know that whoever looks on a woman to lust after her in his heart has already committed adultery with her in his heart, therefore I will not allow my eye to cause me to stumble but my eyes will be single and good and my whole body will be full of light. **Matthew 5:28,29; 6:22**
- Through God's exceedingly great and precious promises, I am a partaker of the divine nature and I have escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. **2 Peter 1:4**
- I will not love the world, nor the things that are in the world. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes and the pride of life is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world passes away and the lust of it, but because I do the will of God, I will abide forever. **1 John 2:15-17**

- I have hidden God's Word in my heart that I might not sin against Him. This is how I am going to keep my way pure—by taking heed to His Word. **Psalm 119:9,11**
- I know that God is not mocked and whatever I sow I will reap, therefore I will not sow to the flesh which brings corruption but I will sow to the Spirit and reap life everlasting. I will not grow weary while doing good, for in due season I will reap because I will not give up. **Galatians 6:7-9**
- I am purifying my soul by obeying the Truth through the Spirit. I will gird up the loins of my mind and as an obedient child, not conform myself to my former lusts as in my ignorance, but as He who called me is holy, I will be holy in all my conduct. **1 Peter 1:22,13-15**
- I will abstain from fleshly lusts which war against my soul—my mind, my will and my emotions. I will no longer live the rest of my time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God. **1 Peter 2:11; 4:2**
- I will not let sin reign in my mortal body. I will not yield the parts of my body as weapons of unrighteousness to sin but I will instead yield the parts of my body as weapons of righteousness for God. **Romans 6:12,13**
- Fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness will not even be named in my life as is proper for saints, neither filthiness, nor foolish talking nor coarse jesting which are not fitting because I know that no fornicator, unclean person, nor covetous man who is an idolater has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. I will let no one deceive me with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the children of disobedience. Therefore I will not be a partaker with them. **Ephesians 5:3-7**
- I will walk as a child of light, proving what is acceptable to the Lord. I will have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness but rather expose them. It is shameful for me to even speak of those things which are done by them in secret. **Ephesians 5:8-12**
- I will put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provision for my flesh to fulfill its desires. I will cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light. I will walk properly as in the day, not in revelry or drunkenness, not in immorality or lewdness, not in strife or envy. **Romans 13:12-14**
- I will discipline, keep under and subdue my body and bring it into subjection and enslave it, lest after I have preached to others, I myself should be cast away, unapproved, disqualified or rejected. **1 Corinthians 9:27**
- I pray that the Lord will incline my heart to His testimonies, and not to covetousness. That He will turn away my eyes from looking at worthless things, and revive me in His way. **Psalm 119:36,37**

- My body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in me, whom I have from God, and I am not my own. For I was bought at a price; therefore I will glorify God in my body and in my spirit, which are God's. **1 Corinthians 6:19,20**
- Although I walk in the flesh I do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of my warfare are not carnal, but they are mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God and bringing into captivity every one of my thoughts and making them obey Christ, being ready to punish all disobedience when my obedience is fulfilled. **2 Corinthians 10:3-6**
- I will not lust after evil things, I will not be an idolater, I will not commit sexual immorality, I will not tempt Christ and I will not murmur. I will stand but will take heed lest I fall. I know that no temptation has overtaken me except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, He will not allow me to be tempted beyond what I am able, but with the temptation will also make a way of escape so that I may be able to bear it. **1 Corinthians 10:6-13**
- And whatever things are true, noble, just, pure, lovely and of good report, I am meditating on these things. **Philippians 4:8**
- I will stand fast in the liberty with which Christ has made me free, and I will not be entangled again with a yoke of sinful bondage. **Galatians 5:1**
- For I have been called to liberty; but I will not use my liberty as an occasion for the flesh, but through love I will serve others. **Galatians 5:13**
- I will walk in the Spirit, and I will not fulfill the lust of the flesh. For the flesh battles against the Spirit, and the Spirit battles against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that I cannot do the things that I want. **Galatians 5:16-17**
- But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self control. Against these there is no law. So if I live in the Spirit, I will also walk in the Spirit. **Galatians 5:22,23,25**
