Declare the Word of God over your Life:

- I am a child of Abraham by faith and therefore an heir according to the promises God made to Abraham. **Galatians 3:27,29**
- As the seed of Abraham, God has promised to bless me and I will be a blessing and those who bless me will be blessed and through me all the families and nations of the earth will be blessed. **Genesis 12:2,3; 22:17,18**

- The Lord will open to me His good treasure, the heavens, to give rain to my land in its season, and to bless all the works of my hands. I will lend to many and not borrow. And the Lord will make me the head and not the tail. **Deuteronomy 28:12,13**
- I will keep the words of this covenant, and do them, and I will prosper in all that I do. **Deuteronomy 29:9**
- I will be strong and very courageous, and observe to do according to all God's law which He has commanded me; I will not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, so that I may prosper wherever I go. **Joshua 1:7**

- If I am willing and obedient, I will eat the good of the land. **Isaiah 1:19**
- My delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law I meditate day and night. Therefore I shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, I will bring forth my fruit in my season, my leaf also shall not wither; and whatever I do shall prosper. **Psalms 1:2-3**
- I am the servant of the Lord and the Lord has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant. **Psalms 35:27**
- The Lord has brought me out into a place of rich fulfillment. **Psalms 66:12**
- The Lord God is my sun and shield; the Lord will give me grace and glory; no good thing will He withhold from me because I walk uprightly. **Psalms 84:11**
- I will honor the Lord with my possessions, and with the first fruits of all my increase; then my barns will be filled with plenty; and my vats will overflow with new wine. **Proverbs 3:9,10**
- The Lord will cause those who love Him to inherit wealth and He will fill their treasuries. **Proverbs 8:21**
- The blessing of the Lord makes me rich, and He adds no sorrow with it. **Proverbs 10:22**
- Riches and honor are with God, enduring riches and righteousness. **Proverbs 8:18**

- The wealth of the sinner is being stored up for me, the righteous. **Proverbs 13:22**
- By humility and the fear of the Lord I will gain riches and honor and life. **Proverbs 22:4**
- If I give money freely I will gain even more but if I withhold money it will tend to poverty. If I am generous I will prosper and be made rich. If I refresh and water others I will be refreshed and watered myself. If I make myself rich I will have nothing but if I make myself poor, I will have great riches. **Proverbs 11:24,25; 13:7**
- God gives wisdom and knowledge and joy to me because I am good in His sight; but to the sinner He gives the work of gathering and storing up wealth, in order that he may hand it over to me because I am pleasing God. **Ecclesiastes 2:26**
- God gives me riches and wealth, and the power to eat of it, to receive my inheritance and rejoice in my labor. This is God's gift to me. **Ecclesiastes 5:19**
- I will bring all God's tithes into His storehouse so that there will be food in His house, and the Lord will open for me the windows of heaven and pour out for me such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it. And the Lord will rebuke the devourer for my sake. **Malachi 3:10,11**
- I will seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added unto me. **Matthew 6:33**
- I will give, and it will be given to me: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be poured into my life. For with exactly the same measure that I use in giving, it will be measured and given back to me. **Luke 6:38**
- Jesus Christ has come that I might have life, and that I might have it more abundantly. **John 10:10**
- Since God did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for me, how shall He not with Him also freely give me all things? **Romans 8:32**
- For I know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for my sake He became poor, that through His poverty I might become rich. **2 Corinthians 8:9**
- My God will supply all my need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. **Philippians 4:19**
- I am going to prosper in all things and be in health, just as my soul prospers. **3 John 2**

- I will take heed and beware of covetousness, for my life does not consist in the abundance of the things I possess. **Luke 12:15**
- I will let my conduct be without covetousness; and I will be content with such things as I have. For the Lord Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you. **Hebrews 13:5**
- And I will not trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives me richly all things to enjoy. I will do good, and be rich in good works. I will be ready to give and willing to share, storing up for myself a good foundation for the time to come, that I may lay hold on eternal life. **1 Timothy 6:17-19**
- I have learned in whatever state I am to be content: I know how to be abased and I know how to abound. In all things I have learned how to be full and how to be hungry; how to abound and how to suffer in need. I can go through all things because Christ strengthens me. **Philippians 4:11-13**
- If I sow sparingly I will also reap sparingly; and if I sow bountifully I will also reap bountifully. And God is able to make all grace abound toward me, that always having all sufficiency in all things, I may have an abundance for every good work. Now He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, will supply and multiply the seed I have sown and increase the fruits of my righteousness, while I am enriched in everything for all liberality. **2 Corinthians 9:6-11**
