

Reaching the Lost

Declare the Word of God over your Life:

Some Scriptures are paraphrased into prayers

Our privilege as believers is to pray for the salvation of people everywhere. It is the desire and will of God to see all people repent and come to the knowledge of the truth.

My friends and family will be saved, I Declare:

- The Lord is not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. **2 Peter 3:9**
- God our Savior desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. **1 Timothy 2:3-4**
- God so loved the world that he gave His only begotten Son that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. **John 3:16**
- Whoever calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. **Acts 2:21; Romans 10:13**

Jesus is the way to salvation:

- Jesus is the way, the truth and the life, no man comes to the Father except through Him. **John 14:6**
- And you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins. **Matthew 1:21**
- Jesus is the door and if any man enters by Him, he shall be saved. **John 10:9**
- Jesus came that we might have life, and that we might have it more abundantly. **John 10:10**
- Through the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, we shall be saved in the same manner as others. **Acts 15:11**
- For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. **1 Corinthians 15:22**
- Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and was buried, and rose again on the third day according to the Scriptures. **1 Corinthians 15:3-4**
- God has given us eternal life and this life is in His Son. **1 John 5:11**
- He who has the Son has life. **1 John 5:12**
- God loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. **1 John 4:10**
- Jesus Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world. **1 John 2:2**
- The God of our fathers raised up Jesus who was murdered by hanging on a tree. Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, to give repentance and the forgiveness of sins. **Acts 5:30-31**
- For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time. **1 Timothy 2:5-6**
- For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us. **1 Thessalonians 5:9-11**
- There is no other name under heaven, given among men by which we must be saved. **Acts 4:12**

Salvation:

- Our God is the God of salvation. **Psalm 68:19-20**

- We will proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day. **Psalm 96:2**
- The gospel is the power of God unto salvation for everyone who believes. **Romans 1:16**
- Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb! **Revelation 7:10**
- The end of our faith is the salvation of our souls. **1 Peter 1:8-12**
- God's ministering spirits are sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation. **Hebrews 1:13-14**
- God saves those who believe. **1 Corinthians 1:21**
- He who believes and is baptized will be saved. **Mark 16:16**
- God is the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him. **Hebrews 5:9**
- How shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation? **Hebrews 2:2-4**
- The grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. **Titus 2:11**
- God has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace. **2 Timothy 1:8-10**
- For by grace we have been saved through faith, and that not of ourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast. **Ephesians 2:8-9**
- Godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation. **2 Corinthians 7:10**
- Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation. **2 Corinthians 6:2**
- I also please all men in all things, not seeking my own profit, but the profit of many, that they may be saved. **1 Corinthians 10:31-33**
- I have become all things to all men that I might by all means save some. Now this I do for the gospel's sake. **1 Corinthians 9:22-23**
- The message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. **1 Corinthians 1:18**
- If we confess with our mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in our heart that God has raised Him from the dead, we will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. **Romans 10:9-10**
- For the redemption of their souls is costly. **Psalm 49:7-8**
- God does not take away a life; but He devises means, so that His banished ones are not expelled from Him. **2 Samuel 14:14**

- God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. **John 3:17**
- The Lord is adding to the church daily those who are being saved. **Acts 2:47**
- And believers are increasingly being added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women. **Acts 5:14**

The Great Commission:

- Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations. **Matthew 28:18-20**
- Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. **Mark 16:15-18**
- Repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. **Luke 24:46-49**
- As the Father has sent Me, I also send you. **John 20:21-22**
- You shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth. **Acts 1:8**

Praying for the Unsaved:

- We pray that people will turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God. **Acts 26:18**
- We pray that people would repent, turn to God, and do works befitting repentance. **Acts 26:20**
- We pray that the unrighteous man will forsake his ways and thoughts. **Isaiah 55:7**
- We pray for sinners to be saved.
- We pray for lost sheep to be found.
- We pray for backsliders to be healed.
- We pray banished ones will not be expelled.
- We pray for prodigals to return to the Father's house.
- We pray God will grant repentance, so that they may know the truth, and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will. **2 Timothy 2:24-26**
